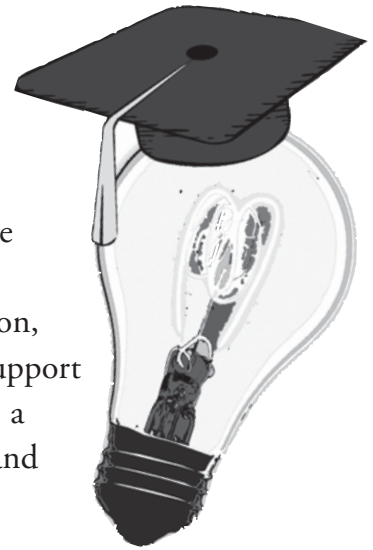
Power to Students Scholarship Applications Available

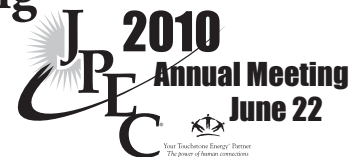
